The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop to share the projected rulemaking process for the implementation of Assembly Bill 1373 (Garcia, Chapter 367, Statutes of 2023) (AB 1373) POU Capacity Payments. This includes reviewing the draft regulations, major milestones, and anticipated outcomes of the rulemaking process. A quorum of commissioners may participate remotely, but no votes will be taken.

The workshop will include a public comment period, and the CEC will request feedback on the draft regulations.

Background

AB 1373 established a new fee structure for publicly owned utilities in the California Independent System Operator balancing area that fail to meet system resource adequacy requirements during a month where the Electricity Supply Strategic Reliability Reserve Program resources are dispatched to meet an identified reliability need and authorized the CEC to adopt regulations to implement the statutory provisions. Draft regulations will be posted in the Resource Planning and Reliability docket 24-OIR-01 at 24-OIR-01.
