## **Hydrogen Fuel Price and fair market competition**

Hydrogen fuel cell drivers do need more stations, but they need reasonable pricing of fuel. Shell- Torrance and Air Products- Woodland Hills offer \$29.99 per kilogram of fuel. All True Zero stations offer fuel at \$36.00 per kilogram.

In either case, drivers who need a full tank are going to spend over \$100 which is comparable to the price of a fill up for gasoline powered vehicles.

We are told the price of fuel has tripled since it first offering and we feel this is unacceptable for powering with alternate fuel that is cheaper to produce than fossil fuel and complies with all California clean air requirements.
