The California Energy Commission (CEC) received Willow Rock Energy Storage Center's (applicant) (formerly GEM A-CAES, LLC), repeated application for confidential designation, dated June 18, 2024 (TN 257035) covering the following documents:

Cultural Resources Phase II Testing Plan
