**Application for Confidential Designation for Data in Power Source
Disclosure Program Annual Report
Docket No. 24-PSDP-01**

Dear Cynthia Clark:

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received the Regents of the University of California's (applicant) application for confidential designation (TN 257484), filed June 27, 2024, covering the following data contained in the Power Source Disclosure Annual Report:

- PSD Schedule 1
Cells N7-N15 (Retail Sales and related subtotals), Columns H-K (Gross MWh Procured, MWh Resold, Net MWh Procured, Adjusted Net MWh Procured), Cells A75-B80 (End uses other than Retail Sales)
- PSD Schedule 2 – Retired Unbundled Renewable Energy Credits (REC)
Column E (Total Retired RECs in MWh)
- PSD Schedule 3 – Annual Power Content Label Data
Cells B13-B25 (Adjusted Net Procured MWh), Cell C27 (Total Retail Sales)

The applicant is an Electric Service Provider. The applicant states that consistent with various California Public Utility Commission decisions, the data should be kept confidential until December 31, 2024, and that the data may be disclosed if aggregated with data from other load-serving entities.

Executive Director's Determination

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b), the CEC shall designate the requested information confidential, without the need for an application, when the applicant is a federal, state, regional, or local agency or

state-created private entity and possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC, that has been designated by the applicant as confidential under the Public Records Act or the Freedom of Information Act. Therefore, under this provision, the above-described information is designated confidential for the requested term until December 31, 2024.

Be advised that under the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2506, one may petition to inspect or copy records that the CEC has designated as confidential. A decision on a petition to inspect or copy confidential records is issued by the CEC's chief counsel. Under the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2507, the executive director may disclose records, or release records previously designated as confidential, in certain circumstances. The procedures for acting on a petition and criteria for disclosing or releasing records previously designated as confidential are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506-2508.
