The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a staff webinar to present the demand scenarios for use in the Senate Bill (SB) 100 (De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) analysis, as well as the inputs and assumptions used to develop the scenarios for the 2025 SB 100 Joint Agency Report. The public can participate in the webinar consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The webinar may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

CEC staff will present the demand scenarios for use in the SB 100 analysis, as well as the inputs and assumptions used to develop the scenarios. Commissioners, if present, will have the opportunity to ask questions of staff and comment on the proposed inputs and assumptions. An opportunity for public questions and comments is also being planned as part of the event.

Background

The 100 Percent Clean Energy Act of 2018 (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) establishes a target for renewable and zero-carbon resources to supply 100 percent of retail sales and electricity procured to serve all state agencies by 2045. SB 100 requires the CEC, California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and California Air Resources Board (CARB) to develop and submit a joint-agency report, SB 100 Joint Agency Report, to the legislature by January 1, 2021,

and at least every four years thereafter. The demand scenarios that will be presented and discussed at this webinar are some of the inputs into the analysis of options to achieving the SB 100 targets of 100 percent clean electricity by 2045 for the 2025 SB 100 Joint Agency Report. The results of the modeling effort will be assessed in the 2025 SB 100 Joint Agency Report.

The requirement for issuing the joint report is codified in the [Public Utilities Code section 454.53](#), and the full text is available at https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC§ionNum=454.53.

The [2021 SB 100 Joint Agency Report](#), available at <https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/EFiling/GetFile.aspx?tn=237167&DocumentContentId=70349>, was published March 15, 2021, and was a first step to evaluate the challenges and opportunities in implementing SB 100. It included an initial assessment of the additional energy resources and the resource building rates needed to achieve 100 percent clean electricity, along with the associated costs. The next SB 100 Joint Agency Report is due to the legislature on January 1, 2025.
