Just saw NEEA's comments, and I do hope NEEA will be vigilant about informing the CEC of updates to the certified heat pump water heater directory and the CBECC and front-end software programmers equally vigilant about implementing sub-version updates to include new product definitions in the NEEA HPWH menu. I have myself experienced the frustration of having a builder or plumbing sub bring a spec for a new model of HPWH which is not yet in the software, so swift turnaround times on NEEA HPWH menu updates are essential.
