My neighbor attended a meeting regarding the proposed energy storage facility. A speaker gave a scientific and technological explanation of these facilities, concluding they arenâ \in TMt inherently bad (we need them in fact), but NOT nestled in a residential community, against hills covered in brush, and with a stream going through the property.

This technology has only been around since 2011 and has been the source of 88 documented fires, 13 fires in 2023 alone. The most recent one being the closure of I-15 near Baker for 3 days by Hazmat after a semi-truck carrying these batteries caught fire. The freeway only opened up yesterday afternoon. When these fires happen the chemical exposure is so bad the area must be evacuated. They are difficult fires to extinguish because they burn super hot, often times from explosion.
