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Notice of Availability of Renewables Portfolio Standard 2017-2020 Verification Results for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities Commission Reports — Group 2 Docket No. 21-RPS-01

The California Energy Commission (CEC) adopted *Renewables Portfolio Standard Verification Results Reports (RPS POU Verification Results Reports)* for 15 local publicly owned electric utilities (POUs) at its June 12, 2024, Business Meeting.¹

The RPS POU Verification Results Reports provide the results of the CEC's verification of renewable energy procurement claims submitted by POUs for Compliance Period 3 of the Renewables Portfolio Standard, covering the years 2017-2020. The RPS POU Verification Results Reports are available on the CEC website at https://www.energy.ca.gov/portfolio/documents/rps verification pous.html.

The Enforcement Procedures for the Renewables Portfolio Standard for Local Publicly Owned Electric Utilities establish the rules and procedures by which the CEC assesses a POU's compliance with RPS procurement requirements.² The methods used by the CEC to verify procurement claims for RPS program participants are generally described in the Renewables Portfolio Standard Eligibility Guidebook, Ninth Edition (Revised) and further explained in the Renewables Portfolio Standard Verification Methodology Report, Third Edition. The verification results included in the *RPS POU Verification Results Reports* provide the following information for the final group of 15 POUs that reported procurement claims for Compliance Period 3:

- The POU's procurement target and portfolio balance requirements and limitations.
- The amount of eligible renewable energy credits (RECs) retired, and the amount applied to meet the compliance period requirements, both shown by Portfolio Content Category classification and Long-Term Procurement Requirement classification, as applicable.
- Deficits in meeting RPS procurement requirements for the compliance period.
- Optional compliance measures being applied by the POU for the compliance period.
- A calculation of excess procurement accumulated in this compliance period.
- A summary of the POU's excess procurement and historic carryover, if any, including any prior balance, the amount accumulated and used in the current compliance period, and remaining balance.
