In accordance with California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 1, section 10-106 and section 10-110, this package of materials includes the City of San José's proposed local ordinance requiring more stringent energy requirements than those set by California's 2022 Building Energy Efficiency Standards Title 24, Part 6.

Please find the following materials enclosed:

- **Att. 1:** Signed Ordinance No. 31081, which amends various sections of Chapter 24.10 of Title 24 of the San Jose Municipal Code to serve as a reach code to increase building efficiency, mandate electric- and solar-readiness and includes requirements for energy reach standards beyond Title 24, Part 6 baseline for new single family residential construction, specifically for single-family residences (and ADUs) under 1,200 square feet.
- **Att. 2:** The associated cost effectiveness study, specific to the City of San José's climate zone.
