The report does not include the views from the trails. Here are pictures from the 25+ mile Colinas Bluff Trail. The Laguna Heights Community Association owns over 200 acres of land in San Juan Capistrano which includes the Colinas Bluff Trail. There are panoramic scenic views from this trail. I took these pictures but if I were on horseback (this trail is equestrian) the views would be better. This a popular public trail, 10 feet wide, and provides exceptional views. The views would be destroyed by 12.4 acres of concrete occupied by 1100 30' containers of Lithium batteries and the various structures supporting this project. The landscape around the perimeter is fine to hide the containers and substation from the freeway traffic but the public would be able to see clearly every container and the enormous concrete pad. These pictures should have been done by Compass and included in the application. The view section needs to be revised, it is not complete.
