**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Presiding Member for the Committees<sup>1</sup> appointed by the California Energy Commission (CEC) to conduct proceedings on the applications for certification

(AFC) of the Morton Bay Geothermal Project,<sup>2</sup> Elmore North Geothermal Project,<sup>3</sup> and Black Rock Geothermal Project,<sup>4</sup> (collectively, Proposed Projects), hereby directs the parties for each project to meet and confer by September 24, 2024 regarding a proposed schedule for the remainder of these proceedings.<sup>5</sup>

Staff and project applicants are further directed to prepare a joint proposed schedule for the remainder of each proceeding and file it in the respective docket for each Proposed Project no later than September 30, 2024. Staff and project applicants may, if necessary, file separate proposed schedules, but if so, must explain the main disagreements that prevented them from filing a joint schedule and must explain the basis for each of the proposals provided. The proposed schedule should include, without limitation, proposed deadlines for staff to file its final staff assessments and proposals for whether the evidentiary hearings should be consolidated, held back-to-back on consecutive days, or held separately. The other parties to each proceeding may join the joint proposed schedule, if any, or may file separate proposed schedules by the same deadline.
