## **Notice of Availability HEEHRA Phase I Contractor Training**

Training for contractors who are interested in delivering Home Electrification and Appliance Rebates (HEEHRA) is now available. Information on the HEEHRA rebate program and training can be found on TECH Clean California's HEEHRA Program page (<https://techcleanca.com/incentives/heehrarebates/>) and The Switch Is On (<https://www.switchison.org/techcleanca>).

HEEHRA Phase I rebates are available through the TECH Clean California initiative and must be delivered through a TECH-certified contractor trained in the HEEHRA rebates.

### **Background**

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), Pub. L. 117-169 (August 16, 2022), authorized the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) to carry out two Home Energy Rebates programs – HEEHRA and Home Efficiency Rebates (HOMES). These two programs provide a combined \$8.8 billion in funds for the benefit of U.S. households, to be distributed to households by state energy offices and Indian Tribes. California received a formula allocation of \$581 million for HEEHRA and HOMES and is required to apply to the DOE with program proposals for review and approval. The DOE is responsible for providing oversight and guidance, and the California Energy Commission (CEC) is responsible for administering rebate programs for the state of California.

Rebates are not available for appliances or equipment purchased or installed before rebate applications are reserved through TECH Clean California. If you are a homeowner who intends to receive a rebate, do not make any purchases until you have reserved your rebate through TECH Clean California and a HEEHRA trained and TECH certified contractor.
