The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a staff workshop on the proposed rulemaking to implement provisions of Public Resources Code Sections **25354 and 25355**, as amended by Senate Bill (SB) X1-2 (Stats. 2023, 1st Ex. Sess. 2023, ch. 1). Topics may include, but are not limited to, rules related to the data collection and analysis provisions in Public Resources Code Sections **25354 and 25355**, including the projections required pursuant to section 25354(c) and refinery maintenance reporting required pursuant to 25354(m).

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

This workshop will discuss proposed CEC regulations or guidelines, or both, and proposed amendments to the existing regulations associated with the Petroleum Industry Information Reporting Act of 1980 (PIIRA) located in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, division 2, chapter 3, article 3 (collectively referred to in this notice as the proposed rules). The proposed rules that will be discussed at this workshop are being developed pursuant to CEC Order No. 23-1018-10 to implement Chapter 4.5 of Division 15 of the Public Resources Code. The proposed rules may address new statutory provisions resulting from the passage of SB X1-2 as well as provisions

that pre-date SB X1-2. Relevant to this rulemaking, SB X1-2 increased the data collection and analysis provisions in Public Resources Code Sections **25354 and 25355**. The proposed rules may address aspects of Public Resources Code Sections **25354 and 25355** pertaining to data collection including, but not limited to, the projections required pursuant to Section 25354(c), the maintenance reporting required pursuant to Section 25354(m), and associated definitions and procedures.

Staff will provide an overview of scope and covered topics for the proposed rules in this phase of the rulemaking proceeding, including formats for data submission.

Background

The CEC administers PIIRA, which requires certain petroleum industry companies to submit weekly, monthly, and annual data to the CEC. Analysis of data collected under PIIRA is an important part of the CEC's responsibility to create a thorough understanding of the operations of the petroleum industry in California. SB X1-2, which took effect in June 2023, amended PIIRA and added other requirements associated with the CEC's oversight of the petroleum industry. Among other things, SB X1-2 revised and introduced several new petroleum industry reporting requirements, with submittals beginning in July 2023. The new information includes spot market transactions, firm ownership, agreements and contracts, inventory holdings by type, refinery maintenance schedules, 96-hour notice of marine vessel imports, expanded refinery operator reporting, and new pipeline and port operator reporting. SB X1-2 also authorized the CEC to regulate the timing of refinery maintenance and turnaround.
