The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a virtual workshop to solicit feedback on the program design of the Homes Electrification and Appliance Rebates (HEEHRA) Program Phase II.

Agenda

Staff will present an overview of the HEEHRA Program and seek feedback on program design for HEEHRA Phase II. Representatives from state and local agencies, utilities, non-governmental organizations, industry, and/or environmental groups may participate in sessions and panel discussions and provide recommendations, considerations, proposed priorities, strategy case examples, and data for staff and decision makers to consider when designing the program. There will also be an opportunity for public comment. A detailed schedule will be posted prior to the workshop.

Background

The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) was signed into law on August 16, 2022, providing \$391 billion to support clean energy and address climate change. California has been awarded \$290 million to implement the HEEHRA Program, which is intended to help households save money on energy bills, improve energy efficiency, reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, and improve indoor air quality. Funding is split into two phases, with \$96M for Phase I and \$194M for Phase II. The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) estimates these rebates will save American households up to \$1 billion on energy bills each year and support over 50,000 U.S. jobs nationwide.

The California HEEHRA Phase I program is leveraging the existing Technology and Equipment for Clean Heating (TECH) Clean California residential electrification rebate program to quickly move funds to Californians. TECH Clean California is a contractor point of sale program that offers electric appliance incentives, technical assistance, and installer training to address barriers associated with building decarbonization market transformation. The CEC is currently developing the HEEHRA Phase II program design to submit to the Department of Energy. CEC is seeking feedback on the program design at this workshop.
