Lots of confusion about HEEHRA requirements

Must I disable my propane radiant heat (boiler also is my water heater) to qualify for HEEHRA rebate? (We don't have natural gas out here). And, must I add a second pump and mini-split(s) costing \$8,000-\$15,000 more to heat my entire home with heat pumps, or can I limit my heat upgrade to a one pump/3 mini-splits system planned for the main part of my home? The single pump and mini-splits will cost around \$30,000-- It makes no sense to spend an additional \$10,000 to qualify for a \$4000 HEEHRA rebate.
