Dear Jeremy Waen:

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received an application for confidentiality from Peninsula Clean Energy Authority (applicant) (TN 260065), docketed November 15, 2024, for select portions of the following power supply data:

- Peninsula Supply Forms Confidential

The applicant seeks confidentiality of certain portions of the information submitted in the data sets, specifically:

- Form S-2_SUPPLY: Row 32, Columns Q-Z; Rows 56-58, Column Q; Rows 91-94, Column F; Row 116, Columns Q-Z; Rows 165-188, Columns Q-Z; Rows 189-220, Columns AD-AM; Rows 232 and 234, Columns Q-Z and AD-AM.
- Form S-2A_Addendum Monthly: Columns G-DV, Rows 68-119.
- S-5 Table: Column I, Rows 10-34 and 45-74.

The applicant requests that the specified portions of the data be designated confidential by the CEC for a period of three years, under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b).

Under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b), the CEC shall designate the requested information confidential when the applicant seeks confidentiality as a federal, state, regional, or local agency or state-created private entity, which possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC, that has been designated by the applicant as confidential under the Public Records Act, or the Freedom of Information Act.

Here, the applicant is a local agency, has itself designated that the data is confidential under the Public Records Act, and the information submitted is pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC. Therefore, the CEC designates the above-described information as confidential a period of three years. Data may be disclosed if aggregated with data from other load serving entities.

Be advised that persons may petition to inspect or copy records that have been designated as confidential, the executive director may disclose, or release records previously designated as confidential in certain circumstances, and the CEC may hold a hearing to determine the confidentiality of its records on its own motion or on a motion by CEC staff. The procedures and criteria for disclosing or releasing, filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions or motions are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506 through 2508.
