**Application for Confidential Designation for San Jose Clean Energy 2024 Electricity Resource Plan
Docket No. 24-IEPR-02**

Dear Taylor Knecht:

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received an application for confidentiality from City of San Jose, administrator of San Jose Clean Energy (applicant) (TN 260077), docketed November 15, 2024, for select portions of the following power supply data:

- Confidential SJCE 2024 IEPR Supply Forms

The applicant seeks confidentiality of certain portions of the information submitted in the data sets, specifically:

- Form S-2, Cells Q32:Z32, Q34:Z397, Q400:Z400, Q402:Z583, Q586:Z586, Q588:Z588, Q590:Z592, AD32:AM32, AD34:AM397, AD400:AM400, AD402:AM583, AD586:AM586, AD588:AM588, AD590:Z592.
- Form S-2A, Cells G10:DV99.
- Form S-5, Cells I9:I135, G35, G37:G38, G40:G41, G43, and G46.

The applicant requests that the highlighted portions of the data be designated confidential by the CEC for a period of three years, under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b).

Under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b), the CEC shall designate the requested information confidential when the applicant seeks confidentiality as a federal, state, regional, or local agency or state-created private entity, which possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC, that has been designated by the applicant as confidential under the Public Records Act, or the Freedom of Information Act.

Here, the applicant is a local agency, has itself designated that the data is confidential under the Public Records Act, and the information submitted is pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC. Therefore, the CEC designates the above-described information as confidential a period of three years. Data may be disclosed if aggregated with data from other load serving entities.

Be advised that persons may petition to inspect or copy records that have been designated as confidential, the executive director may disclose, or release records previously designated as confidential in certain circumstances, and the CEC may hold a hearing to determine the confidentiality of its records on its own motion or on a motion by CEC staff. The procedures and criteria for disclosing or releasing, filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions or motions are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506 through 2508.
