The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received an application for confidentiality from Central Coast Community Energy (applicant) (TN 260538), docketed December 6, 2024, for select portions of the following power supply data:

CCCE Supply Forms Confidential

The applicant seeks confidentiality of certain portions of the information submitted in the data sets, specifically:

- S-1\_REQUIREMENT: Columns I-R, Rows 11,19-22, and 25.
- S-2\_SUPPLY: Rows 32-41, Columns Q-Z; Rows 27-41, Columns AD-AM; and Rows 47-49, Columns Q-Z and AD-AM.

The applicant requests that the specified portions of the data be designated confidential by the CEC for a period of three years, until December 6, 2027, under California Code of Regulations, title 20, 2505(b).

Under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(b), the CEC shall designate the requested information confidential when the applicant seeks confidentiality as a federal, state, regional, or local agency or state-created private entity, which possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC, that has been designated by the applicant as confidential under the Public Records Act, or the Freedom of Information Act.

Here, the applicant is a local agency, has itself designated that the data are confidential under the Public Records Act, and the information submitted is pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC. Therefore, the CEC designates the above-described information as confidential a period of three years. Data may be disclosed if aggregated with data from other load serving entities.

Be advised that persons may petition to inspect or copy records that have been designated as confidential, the executive director may disclose, or release records previously designated as confidential in certain circumstances, and the CEC may hold a

hearing to determine the confidentiality of its records on its own motion or on a motion by CEC staff. The procedures and criteria for disclosing or releasing, filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions or motions are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506 through 2508.
