JOINT ORDER EXTENDING DEADLINE TO JANUARY 17, 2025, TO REPLY TO STAFF'S RESPONSES TO THE COMMITTEE REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION ON CULTURAL AND TRIBAL CULTURAL RESOURCES

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Presiding Member for the Committees¹ appointed by the California Energy Commission (CEC) to conduct proceedings on the applications for certification

¹ For documents, see the "Availability of Documents" section, below. On May 31, 2023, the CEC adopted orders appointing the following committees:

(AFC) of the Morton Bay Geothermal Project,² Elmore North Geothermal Project,³ and Black Rock Geothermal Project,⁴ (collectively, Proposed Projects), **grants** the motion filed jointly by the project applicants⁵ (Applicants) on January 3, 2025 (Motion).⁶ Thus, the time is extended **from January 8, 2025 to January 17, 2025** for Applicants, Intervenors, local and tribal governments, and other interested persons to reply to the CEC staff (Staff) responses, filed December 18, 2024,⁷ to the Committees' requests for information about Staff's cultural and tribal cultural resources analyses.⁸

Background

On December 5, 2024, the Committees issued a revised joint scheduling order and request for information about Staff's cultural and tribal cultural resources analyses (Order).⁹ The Order directed Staff to file responses to the Committee questions by December 18, 2024, and directed Applicants to file a reply to Staff's responses by January 8, 2025. The Order also invited Intervenors, local and tribal governments, and other interested persons to address the Committees' requests for information about Staff's cultural and tribal cultural resources analysis and reply to Staff's responses by January 8, 2025.

On December 18, 2024, Staff timely filed responses to the Committees' request for information.¹⁰

On January 3, 2025, Applicants filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time to file a reply to

Staff's December 18, 2024, responses to the Committee questions.¹¹ The motion states the extension will allow Applicants to file a more complete response, including potentially incorporating feedback from discussions with tribal representatives into its reply. The motion also asserts that no other parties would be prejudiced by the extension. The motion states that Applicants contacted the other parties about their extension request. Applicants represent that in response: Staff and intervenor Supporters Alliance for Environmental Responsibility stated they do not object to the extension; California Unions for Reliable Energy took no position on the motion and reserved the right to file a response; and the other parties didn't respond. As supported in Applicants' supplemental filing,¹² Staff stated it does not oppose the extension requested in the Motion.

Discussion and Order

The Presiding Member reminds Applicants to file any future scheduling motions in a timely manner that will allow the other parties at least 7 days to respond and to attach documentary evidence to support any representations made in points and authorities in the motion.

Nevertheless, based on Staff's non-opposition, the Presiding Member of the Committees finds that the extension will not prejudice the other parties and hereby **GRANTS** the Motion. Thus, the time is hereby **extended from January 8, 2025, to January 17, 2025,** for Applicants and Intervenors to address the Committees' requests for information about Staff's cultural and tribal cultural resources analysis and respond to Staff's reply filed December 18, 2024. Further, should any local or tribal governments, or other interested persons, choose to submit a response to Committees' requests for information Member requests that they do so by January 17, 2025.
