Background

On September 23, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Executive Order N-79-20, setting a 100 percent ZEV target for new passenger vehicle sales by 2035 and 100 percent ZEV operations target for medium- and heavy-duty vehicles in the state by 2045. Many state agencies and efforts are underway to support this goal.

The first ZIP, released in December 2022, described the state's short- and long-term actions to ensure ZEV infrastructure deployments will meet the needs of the growing ZEV market. The Draft 2024 ZIP proposes a funding deployment plan to meet the goals of the light-duty passenger vehicle market and medium- and heavy-duty truck and bus market. CEC is seeking feedback from the public on the Draft 2024 ZIP.
