The Communities in Charge Project team is excited to invite you to the Funding Wave 2 Cost Reimbursement Webinar!

Communities in Charge is designed to transform electric vehicle (EV) accessibility, rapidly catalyze new markets, and swiftly deploy Level 2 EV charging stations. Communities in Charge is California's market-accelerating, light-duty electric vehicle EV charging incentive project funded by the California Energy Clean Transportation Program and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund, implemented by CALSTART, and supported in partnership with GRID Alternatives and Tetra Tech.

Following the successful completion of their project sites, grant awardees become eligible to submit for cost reimbursements as a final payment.
