BACKGROUND

The Petition proposes to make on-site drainage improvements to the project site which would allow for a small percentage of the treated stormwater "to be used for cooling tower make-up water at Magnolia Power Project (MPP) or infiltrated into the ground, or a combination of the two" (TN#259131). Staff needs confirmation no conditions of certification (COCs) for Air Quality would need to be modified and emissions of the cooling tower would not exceed the permitted limits.
