



Please rank the topics you feel are the biggest hindrance to increased compliance of the energy code?

- AHJ resources

- Insulation and Envelope Sealing
- Lack of consequences for contractors and designers
- Little incentive for ahjs to enforce code
- New custom homes and new production housing should have different rules and requirements.
- quality of compliance documentation

- Secure alternative data collection technologies
