

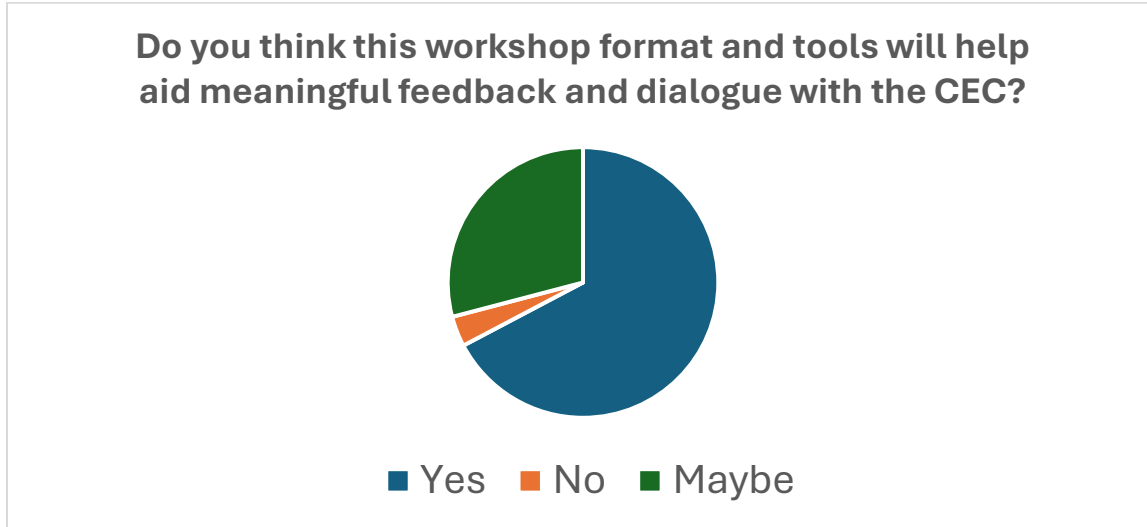

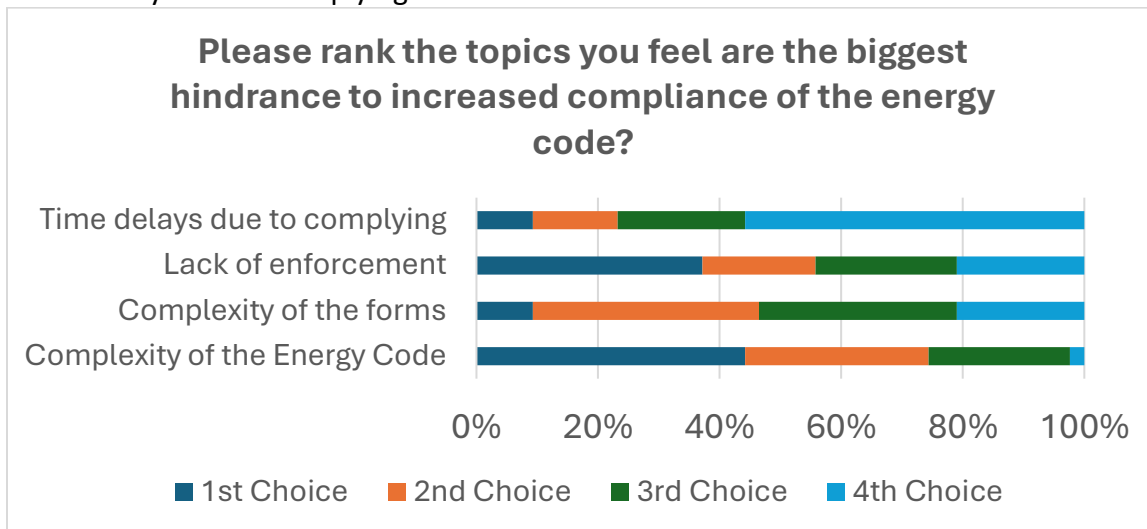

Please rank the topics you feel are the biggest hindrance to increased compliance of the energy code?

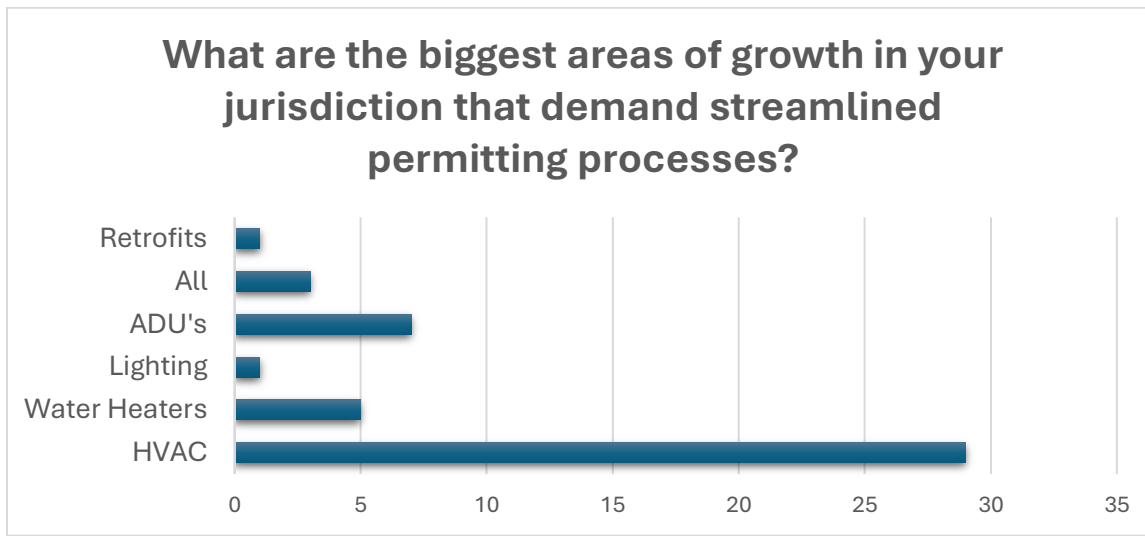

Other issues that we missed?

- AHJ resources
- Complete lack of educational resources
- Contractors willing to ignore the energy code and install equipment without educating homeowners of the benefit for code compliant systems
- Insulation and Envelope Sealing
- Lack of consequences for contractors and designers
- Little incentive for ahjs to enforce code
- New custom homes and new production housing should have different rules and requirements.
- quality of compliance documentation
- Quantifying the lack of enforcement must be done vs relying on data estimates
- Secure alternative data collection technologies
- Solar PV and battery storage installations
- There is no penalty for bad contractors so there is no way to discourage non-compliance
- Transition from HERS to ECC
