**Project Location:** RCEC is located at the intersection of Enterprise and Whitesell streets in the industrial corridor of the city of Hayward in Alameda County, California.

**Project Description:** The amendment proposed by this petition is the permanent installation of a 6,667 gallon tank for storage of sodium hydroxide.

**Modification Description:** The project owner proposes installing a permanent 6,667 gallon tank for storage of sodium hydroxide to use in the project's zero liquid discharge (ZLD) system and for cooling tower pH control. The on-site tank would be installed adjacent to the project's ZLD facility and replace the temporary tanks and temporary secondary containment structures that are currently in use.

On November 22, 2017, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code, finding that:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment;
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project;
3. The project is in compliance with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards; and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
