To facilitate Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) Onsite Wastewater System Program approval/clearance for a proposed project on a parcel with an Onsite Wastewater System(s) (OWS) and/or a private or small potable water supply system(s), the Property Owner (Applicant) must submit a Service Request Application (SRA) and fees to the ACDEH Finance Department in accordance with the instructions below:

STEP 1: The Applicant must complete all fields on pages one (1) and two (2). If a particular field on the form does not apply to your project, check the not applicable box. SRA's that are not legible or complete and do not include the property owner's contact information and signature will not be accepted.

STEP 2: Return the completed SRA (pages one [1] through five [5]) and fees to the ACDEH Finance Department using one of the methods described below. Contact Finance Department if you need additional information at (510) 567-6858.

- In Person. Submittal of the SRA and fees may be made in person at the Finance Department located at 1131 Harbor Bay Parkway in Alameda. Payments may be made via cash, check, money order, or credit card. The front desk located in the lobby of the building will direct you to the Finance Department Office. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. (except County Holidays).
- Online. Submittal of the SRA and fees may be made online to the ACDEH Finance Department at . dehwebbilling@acgov.org. Upon receipt the SRA, the Finance Department will email the applicant an invoice and payment instructions.
- Mail-In. Submittal of the SRA and fees may be made by mail to the Finance Department to the following address: Alameda County Environmental Health, Finance Office, P.O. Box N, Alameda, CA 94501-0108.

STEP 3: ACDEH will send a written response within five (5) business days to the Applicant confirming receipt of an SRA and fees.

Additional Information on SRA's and Fees

Submittal of Initial SRA & Fees

To initiate ACDEH Onsite Wastewater's Program approval/clearance for a proposed project, the Applicant must submit an SRA for an Initial File Review and fees of \$348 to ACDEH. A SRA for an Initial File Review can obtained on ACDEH OWS Program's website located at https://deh.acgov.org/landwater/owts.page?

Upon receipt of the SRA and fees, ACDEH OWS Program staff will conduct a review of the files associated with parcel(s) identified on the SRA and provide the Applicant with a written File Summary Review and Estimated Regulatory Path and Fees for Project Approval/Clearance within fifteen (15) business days of receipt of the SRA and fees. Depending on the project complexity, ACDEH may schedule a consultation meeting with the property owner and their consultants/contractors, and other regulatory agencies to facilitate a clear understanding of stakeholder's responsibilities.

The purpose of the initial file review is for ACDEH to evaluate the proposed project for compatibility with OWS and potable water supply systems on the property and determine an estimated regulatory path and fees for project approval/clearance.

Additional consultation meetings may be required throughout the ACDEH OWS Program approval/clearance process with additional stakeholders critical to the project approval/clearance including but not limited to the property owner, property owner tenants, consultants (e.g., OWS designers/service providers/contractors, architects, civil engineers, landscape architects) and regulatory agencies with jurisdiction over the project.

Submittal of Additional SRA's & Fees

Subsequent to ACDEH's Initial File Review, the Applicant may be required to submit additional SRA's and fees to ACDEH to facilitate project approval/clearance in accordance with the *File Summary Review and Estimated Regulatory Path and Fees for Project Approval/Clearance*. ACDEH will include an SRA with the transmittal of the *File Summary Review and Estimated Regulatory Path and Fees for Project Approval/Clearance* that identifies the Service Request Types on pages three (3) through five (5) of the SRA that are estimated for project/approval clearance. In order to continue with ACDEH OWS Program project oversight the Applicant will be required to submit the SRA and identified minimum fees to ACDEH's Finance Department in accordance with the instructions above.

If the estimated minimum fees for project approval/clearance are depleted based on the project complexity and ACDEH OWS Program staff hours required to complete a task(s), <u>additional fees will be invoiced to the Applicant</u>. Failure to pay fees by the due date identified on the invoice will result in a delay in ACDEH OWS Program clearance/approval of the project and may be cause for issuance of a citation, penalty fees, non-renewal and/or revocation of a permit by ACDEH.

Fee Structure & Project Specific Fee Determination

ACDEH'S OWS Program regulatory oversite fees are based on an hourly rate of \$174 per hour and the level of effort and staff hours required to approve/clear projects involving parcels with OWS and/or potable water supply systems. ACDEH's fees are established at levels that allow cost recovery for services provided and were adopted by Alameda County Board of Supervisors with an effective date of July 1, 2021.

Project specific fees associated with ACDEH permitting/clearance of projects involving parcels with OWS and/or potable water supply systems will depend on the following:

- The level of effort and staff hours required to review the files with historical records of the parcel(s), OWS, local Planning and Building Department approvals/permits, and other agencies with regulatory jurisdiction over OWS;
- The complexity of the existing and proposed OWS and site constrains (i.e., type of OWS, supporting documents, third
 party review, etc.);
- The number of site visits required to observe site conditions, OWS performance evaluations, and installation/abandonment of OWS;
- The complexity of site development projects associated with the OWS (i.e., residential, commercial, etc.);
- Interagency coordination with local Building and Planning Departments, Zone 7 Water Agency, Regional Water Quality Control Board, State Water Resources Control Board, and other agencies with regulatory jurisdiction;
- Easement and variance requirements; and/or
- The accuracy of documents submitted to ACDEH for review and the number of review cycles of revised documents
 required during the approval process.

Provide a brief project description:

Levy Alameda, LLC (Applicant), a wholly owned subsidiary of Obra Maestra Renewables, LLC, proposes to construct, operate, and eventually repower or decommission the 400 megawatt (MW) Potentia-Viridi Battery Energy Storage System on approximately 85 acres in eastern Alameda County. The primary components of the Project include an up to 3,200 megawatt-hour (MWh) battery energy storage system (BESS) facility, an operations and maintenance (O&M) building, a project substation, a 500 kilovolt (kV) overhead intertie transmission (gen-tie) line, and interconnection facilities within the Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) owned and operated Tesla Substation.

Following construction of the BESS facility, an O&M building would be constructed within the primary laydown yard for the Project's anticipated 18 full-time operations staff. The O&M building would include parking, outside equipment and laydown areas, basic offices, meeting rooms, washroom facilities and climate-controlled storage for certain equipment and materials. A potable water storage tank would provide water for washroom and sanitary facilities, and sewage/wastewater would be collected in separate tanks. Potable water would be trucked to the water storage tank periodically during O&M, and sewage/wastewater would be pumped from the storage tank, transported offsite via truck, and disposed of at a sanitary dump station, as needed, during operations. The O&M building would be powered via a distribution line from the Project substation.

The average number of employees will be 18. A majority of the 18 will be there for daytime shifts, but some will be there for nighttime shifts. Work schedules will be 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM for daytime shifts and 7:00 PM - 7:00 AM for nighttime shifts. There will be two, 12-hour shifts per day. One daytime and one nighttime.
