Dear Government Reporting Specialist (Refiners and Major Marketers):

Subject: Compliance with Public Resources Code Section 25354(c)

At the February 12, 2025, business meeting, the California Energy Commission (CEC) adopted emergency regulations to clarify reporting requirements for petroleum refiner and major marketer three-month projections. These regulations were approved by the Office of Administrative Law and may be reviewed by visiting https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/GetDocument.aspx?tn=261961. These regulations will be in place from February 24, 2025, to February 25, 2027. During this period, the CEC may undergo the regular rulemaking process to make these regulations permanent.

Effective April 21, 2025, all refiners and major petroleum products marketers are required to use the new forms prepared by the CEC for these reports pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1366.

The Three-Month Refinery Projections Report (M05) collects data on receipts, inputs, production, shipments, and stocks. The Marketer Projected Receipts and Distributions Report (M07) collects data on receipts and distributions. M05s and M07s are due no later than 30 days after the last day of each month.
