The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a meeting of the Advisory Committee for the Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan. The meeting will discuss proposed guiding principles that the CEC will use to develop the *2025–2026 Investment Plan Update for the Clean Transportation Program*. Background

Assembly Bill (AB) 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007) created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorized the CEC to develop and deploy zero-emission and other advanced fuels and transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change policies. Most recently, AB 126 (Reyes, Chapter 319, Statutes of 2023) reauthorized the Clean Transportation Program until July 1, 2035, with some added and changed requirements.

Statute (Health & Safety Code § 44272.7) requires the CEC to annually update an investment plan for the Clean Transportation Program. Projects funded by the CEC under the program must be consistent with the priorities established in the investment plan. The Clean Transportation Program has a base annual budget of about \$100 million and provides financial and technical support for projects including electric vehicle charging and hydrogen refueling infrastructure; workforce training programs; and related efforts.

In recent years, the CEC has also received state General Funds and Greenhouse Gas Reduction Funds for clean transportation projects. The investment plan update incorporates both base Clean Transportation Program funds and the additional funds to provide a holistic view of funding allocations. The proposed guiding principles for the *2025–2026 Investment Plan Update*, and all related documents, will be available in this online Investment Plan Update docket found at https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=25-ALT-01.

Statute (Health & Safety Code § 44272.5) also directs the CEC to create and consult with an advisory body as the CEC develops the investment plan, the Advisory Committee for the Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan.
