California Energy Commission,

The California State Pipe Trades Council (CSPTC) was approved as an Acceptance Test Technician Certification Provider (ATTCP) for non-Residential Mechanical Acceptance Test Technicians and Employers on September 14, 2016.

We have approved Local Union Training Centers in San Francisco, Santa Rosa, Fresno, Los Angeles, Concord, San Jose, and Sacramento that are currently teaching the curriculum outlined in the latest update submitted by the California State Pipe Trades Council and approved by the California Energy Commission. As of January 1, 2025, we have 206 Mechanical Acceptance Test Technicians (MATTs) and another 65 that are in various stages of fulfilling their requirements to become Mechanical Test Technicians.

As of December 31, 2024, we also have 41 Mechanical Acceptance Test Employers (MATEs). In 2024 we had 65 lapsed certifications for MATTs, and 42 for MATEs. Reports in excel format for all MATEs and MATTs are included with this submission.

We continue to be proactive in seminars being conducted to bring contractors up to speed on the Title 24 CA Energy Code regarding Acceptance Test Technician Certification Providers for Non-Residential Mechanical Acceptance Test Technician Employers. Seminars are held on a quarterly basis.

Independent oversight of the certification processes and procedures are administered by the ESCO Group. For the year of January 1 to December 31, 2024, the ESCO Group flagged one form submission from CSPTC certified Technicians for follow-up. An audit is expected to be performed on this submission in 2025.

We have also included a report from ESCO detailing the Acceptance Tests performed by CSPTC MATTs that include the county where the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) is located, and the number of acceptance tests completed by type during the reporting period and to date.

We believe this update certifies that the CSPTC ATTCP curriculum has met all requirements for this program as specified in our application and approved by the Energy Commission.
