As part of the 2025 Integrated Energy Policy Report Gas Demand Forecast process, the California Energy Commission sought from San Diego Gas & Electric Company (“SDG&E”) daily gas demand by customer category for the two most recent years, 2023 and 2024 (“SDGE_2025 Forms for Submitting Gas Demand and Rate Forecasting Information, Form 1.4”). Portions of that daily gas demand data are confidential. Previously, SDG&E submitted substantially similar data to the California Energy Commission which an application for confidential designation was granted by the Executive Director pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4). (See June 30, 2023, CEC letter from D. Bohan to SDG&E granting confidential designation for daily gas demand data, Docket No. 23-IEPR-03.)

Certification of Confidentiality by Gavin Fuchs Pursuant to Title 20, §2505(a)(4) (Repeated Applications for Confidential Designation)

I, Gavin Fuchs, do certify as follows:

1. I am a Customer Operations Analytics Supervisor within the Customer Services Department of San Diego Gas & Electric Company. I have reviewed the confidential information provided for core and noncore customers within the SDGE_2025 Forms for Submitting Gas Demand and Rate Forecasting Information, Form 1.4 and am familiar with its contents. I am also familiar with the contents of the previous request for daily gas demand data which was granted confidential designation on June 30, 2023.
- ~~2.~~ The daily gas demand data being provided here is substantially similar to the daily gas demand data that was previously granted confidential treatment on June 30, 2023. The only difference between the data for which confidential treatment is requested here and that which was previously requested are the dates of the data provided and the inclusion of confidential “Core Industrial” customer data within the “Core Commercial” field. The June 30, 2023, letter from the CEC to SDG&E granted confidential designation for both “Core Industrial” and “Core Commercial” fields.
3. The facts and circumstances for granting confidential treatment of this data are unchanged from SDG&E’s previous submission reflected in the June 30, 2023, CEC letter.

4. The portions of the data for which confidential treatment is sought are marked with yellow highlighting.
