I. STAFF'S SUMMARY OF MAJOR ISSUES

Pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1709.7(b), staff hereby files its summary statement of issues in the Procter & Gamble Cogeneration Project Application for Certification (AFC).

The Procter & Gamble AFC was filed on October 12, 1993, and deemed data adequate on November 17, 1993. With the Commission determination of data adequacy, the Commission staff is engaged in the discovery phase of the Procter & Gamble project review. On December 3, 1993, the Commission staff served its data requests on the applicant. Responses to these data requests are expected on or before January 3, 1994.

Because the Commission staff has only begun to evaluate the project, it is difficult to identify with certainty what, if any, major issues exist. Issues may arise during staff's review and analysis of the applicant's data responses, review by other interested regulatory agencies, or review by the general public. However, given our review of the Procter & Gamble AFC to date, staff does not foresee any major issues at this time.

II. STAFF'S SCHEDULING STATEMENT


The Committee's Notice of Informational Presentation; Scheduling Conference; Site Visit dated November 23, 1993, stated that a scheduling conference would be conducted, the purpose being to establish a schedule for procedural matters necessary to complete the proceedings in a timely manner.

Under the statutory twelve-month review period for AFC's mandated by Public Resources Code section 25540.6, staff would conduct discovery and issue its Preliminary Staff Assessment and Final Staff Assessment in mid-April and early June of 1994, respectively.

Staff will exercise efforts to expedite the review of this project without sacrificing professional integrity or quality of its work product. An example of this effort is that staff submitted its first data requests to the applicant on December 3, 1993, just 16 days after acceptance.

To the extent that it is able, staff intends to continue this good faith effort to expedite the review of the Procter & Gamble Application for Certification.
