Staff Proposed Revision to Condition **WORKER SAFETY-5**
October 2013

WORKER SAFETY-5 The project owner shall ensure that a portable automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) and Trauma/First-Aid kits sufficient to handle anticipated industrial accidents are is located on-site during construction and operations and shall implement a program to ensure that workers are properly trained in AED use and basic first aid (which includes CPR) and that the equipment is properly maintained and functioning at all times. During construction and commissioning, the following persons shall be trained in its AED use and basic first aid (which includes CPR) and at least one of the following supervisors shall be on-site whenever the workers that they supervise are on-site: the Construction Project Manager or delegate, the Construction Safety Supervisor or delegate, and all shift foremen. During operations, all power plant employees shall be trained in its AED use and basic first aid (which includes CPR). A plan for locating AEDs and first aid kits and the training program shall be submitted to the CPM for review and approval.

VERIFICATION: ~~At least 60~~ Within 14 days ~~prior to~~ after the start of site mobilization, the project owner shall submit to the CPM proof that portable automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) and trauma/first aid kits exists on-site. At least 60 days prior to the start of site mobilization, the project owner shall provide ~~and~~ a plan for locating AEDs and first aid kits and a copy of the training and maintenance program for review and approval.
