AES Southland Development, L.L.C. (the "Applicant") hereby files this notice pursuant to Section 1716(f) of the Commission's regulations (Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations) relating to Data Request Set 1R (SET 1 Nos. 26-28 Revised) issued by Commission Staff on November 20, 2013.


At the workshop for the Redondo Beach Energy Project held on December 5, 2013, Commission Staff and Applicant had a mutually informative discussion regarding Data Requests 26R and 28R, and potential methods to satisfy Commission Staff's request for information. The Applicant requires an extension of the dates specified in Section 1716 to develop a noise monitoring plan that could be responsive to these data requests. The Applicant requires additional time to evaluate methods to obtain and provide the information requested, to identify monitoring locations, and to obtain permission from

property owners for use of such locations for noise monitoring. Therefore, the Applicant is requesting a 45-day extension of the dates specified in Section 1716.
