Re: Redondo Beach Energy Project (12-AFC-03): Notice of Additional Time Required Pursuant to 20 C.C.R. 1716(f): Staff Data Request Set 2, Data Request 68

Dear Commissioner Douglas and Commissioner Scott:

AES Southland Development, L.L.C. (the "Applicant") hereby files this notice pursuant to Section 1716(f) of the Commission's regulations (Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations) relating to Data Request Set 2 (Nos. 67-70), Data Request 68 issued by Commission Staff on December 20, 2013.

Data Request 68 requests that the Applicant "summarize the operating conditions for the [Air Cooled Condenser ("ACC")], including heat rejection, exhaust temperature, and exhaust velocity." Data Request 68 also requests "values to complete the table, and additional data as necessary for staff to determine how the heat rejection load varies with ambient conditions and also determine at what conditions ACC cells may be shut down, and for staff to model thermal plume." The Applicant is working to respond to Data Request 68, and has requested data from a third-party vendor, which it has

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not yet received. This data is necessary to calculate the values and summarize the operating conditions for the ACC requested in Data Request 68. Once the Applicant receives the information, it will be able to provide a response to Data Request 68.

Therefore, the Applicant requires an extension of the dates specified in Section 1716 to obtain the requested information. The Applicant expects that a response to Data Request 68 will be provided on or before February 10, 2014.
