This is regarding the application by AES to construct a proposed new power plant in Redondo Beach, to replace the existing old facility there.

This location is on the border between Redondo Beach and neighboring Hermosa Beach to the north. There are many single-family and high-density multi-family residential uses located in very close proximity to the power plant site in both Redondo Beach and Hermosa Beach. A proposed new power plant at this location would cause significant air quality, noise, public safety and quality of life problems for the residents living nearby. Please note that the existing facility has been a source of problems in the community for many, many years.

It is my understanding that studies have been done and they conclusively show that the air pollution from a proposed new power plant would cause major medical problems and possibly even deaths in the nearby residential communities.
