SUBJECT: FOLLOWING UP ON RBPD RESPONSES ON THE LAW ENFORCEMENT NEEDS ASSESSMENT FORM FOR THE PROPOSED REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT

GOOD MORNING CAPTAIN HINK,

SEVERAL MONTHS AGO YOU SENT ME RESPONSES ON A LAW ENFORCEMENT NEEDS ASSESSMENT FORM FOR THE PROPOSED REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT. YOUR RESPONSES ARE VERY HELPFUL AND I WANTED TO FOLLOW UP WITH YOU ON SOME OF YOUR RESPONSES. I HAVE ATTACHED A COPY OF YOUR RESPONSES TO REFRESH YOUR MEMORY.

YOU HAD EXPRESSED CONCERNS THAT DURING CONSTRUCTION AND THEN ONCE THE PLANT
BECOMES OPERATIONAL, PUBLIC PROTESTS AND DEMONSTRATIONS MAY REQUIRE RBPD TO ASSIGN
PERSONNEL TO THE SITE ON A PERIODIC BASIS DURING CONSTRUCTION TO MAINTAIN THE PEACE.
YOU ALSO SAID THAT RBPD WOULD NEED TO CREATE A THREAT ASSESSMENT TO PREVENT
TARGETED VIOLENCE AGAINST THE FACILITY ONCE IT BECOMES OPERATIONAL.

YOU HAD ALSO RESPONDED THAT THE INCREASED PROJECT-RELATED TRAFFIC NEAR THE CONSTRUCTION SITE COULD DELAY THE RESPONSE TIME OF EMERGENCY PERSONNEL TO THE SITE AND OTHER LOCATIONS ALONG HARBOR DRIVE, ESPECIALLY DURING WEEKENDS AND SUMMER MONTHS WHEN TRAFFIC IN THE AREA IS AT HIGH CAPACITY. I HAVE PASSED YOUR COMMENTS ALONG TO MY COLLEAGUE WHO IS PREPARING THE TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORTATION SECTION AND HE IS CONSIDERING YOUR COMMENTS IN HIS ANALYSIS. YOU ALSO EXPRESSED THAT RBPD DOES NOT ANTICIPATE ANY INCREASE TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIMES ONCE THE SITE BECOMES OPERATIONAL.

ENERGY COMMISSION STAFF TYPICALLY PLACES CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION ON POWER PLANT PROJECTS, REQUIRING SITE-SPECIFIC CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATIONS SITE SECURITY PLANS. I HAVE ATTACHED A COPY OF THE TWO CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION (ONE FOR CONSTRUCTION AND ONE FOR OPERATIONS) THAT THE ENERGY COMMISSION WOULD TYPICALLY APPLY TO A PROJECT LIKE THE PROPOSED REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT. COULD YOU TAKE A LOOK AT THESE CONDITIONS AND LET ME KNOW IF THESE SITE CONTROL RESTRICTIONS WOULD HELP REDUCE THE NEED FOR RBPD PERSONNEL RESPONSE AT THE FACILITY?

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ENERGY COMMISSION STAFF ALSO TYPICALLY REQUIRE THE PREPARATION OF AND COMPLIANCE WITH A TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN. TYPICALLY TRAFFIC CONTROL PLANS ADDRESS THE MOVEMENT OF WORKERS, VEHICLES, AND MATERIALS, INCLUDING ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE SCHEDULES AND DESIGNATED WORKFORCE AND DELIVERY ROUTES AND REQUIRES THE PROJECT APPLICANT TO CONSULT WITH CALTRANS AND APPLICABLE LOCAL JURISDICTIONS (EG. CITY OF REDONDO BEACH). I HAVE ATTACHED A COPY OF A CONDITION OF CERTIFICATION RECENTLY PROPOSED FOR THE HUNTINGTON BEACH ENERGY PROJECT, WHICH IS A SIMILAR PROJECT TO THE REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT. ENERGY COMMISSION STAFF WOULD PROPOSE A SIMILAR CONDITION FOR THE REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT.

WITH THE INCORPORATION OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATIONS SITE-SPECIFIC SECURITY PLANS AND TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN, AS TYPICALLY PROPOSED BY ENERGY COMMISSION STAFF AS A CONDITION OF CERTIFICATION FOR THE REDONDO BEACH ENERGY PROJECT, WOULD THESE CONDITIONS ADDRESS YOUR CONCERNS ABOUT PUBLIC PROTESTS AND DEMONSTRATIONS AND INCREASES IN EMERGENCY RESPONSE TIMES?

THANK YOU FOR TAKING A LOOK AT THESE CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION AND CONSIDERING RBPD'S CONCERNS IN LIGHT OF THESE CONDITIONS. PLEASE LET ME KNOW IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS. I LOOK FORWARD TO HEARING FROM YOU,

HI LISA,

I READ THE INFORMATION THAT YOU SENT. I BELIEVE THAT THE STATED CONDITIONS THAT WOULD BE IMPOSED UPON THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT WOULD ADEQUATELY ADDRESS OUR CONCERNS RELATED TO TRAFFIC FLOW AND VEHICLE ACCESS TO THE AREA, THEREBY REDUCING THE NECESSITY FOR POLICE OVERSIGHT. HOWEVER, NONE OF THE EXEMPLAR CONDITIONS THAT I READ SPECIFICALLY ADDRESS THE TOPIC OF PUBLIC PROTESTS. SINCE IT IS LIKELY THAT PEOPLE WILL PROTEST DURING THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE, IT WOULD BE BENEFICIAL TO HAVE CONDITIONS IN PLACE THAT REGULATE THE MANAGEMENT OF PROTESTORS AND FURTHER REDUCE THE NECESSITY FOR A POLICE RESPONSE.
