STATUS REPORT 4

On August 28, 2013, the El Segundo Amendment Committee issued a "Scheduling Order" requiring status reports on October 3, 2013, December 3, 2013 and February 25, 2014.

Energy Commission staff continues to work on their technical sections for the Preliminary Staff Assessment (PSA). The project owner has been providing clarifications to data requests and providing additional supplemental data responses to address staff's questions. The additional information that was anticipated from the project owner the week of January 27, 2014, was submitted on February 12, 2014. While this data provided much of the information that was needed, the Cultural Resources records search report is still outstanding, and Biological Resources staff has some clarifying questions on the information that was docketed on February 12, 2014. At this time, staff is uncertain as to when the project owner will provide all the outstanding data.

Staff believes that enough of the data gaps have been filled to publish the PSA and intends to publish the week of March 7, 2014. Workshops will be scheduled in the City of El Segundo shortly after the PSA is published. Information that has been received too late to incorporate into the PSA will be discussed in workshops and added to the Final Staff Assessment.
