NOTICE OF RECEIPT

PETITION TO AMEND THE CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION DECISION FOR THE MIDWAY SUNSET COGENERATION PROJECT (85-AFC-3C)

On November 21, 2013, the Midway Sunset Cogeneration Company (MSCC) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting to allow the divestiture of approximately 9,000 feet of the existing steam distribution system that is no longer needed to operate the Midway Sunset Cogeneration project (Midway Sunset). The 225-megawatt project was certified by the Energy Commission on May 14, 1987, and began commercial operation on May 1, 1989. Midway Sunset is a cogeneration facility located in Fellows, Kern County, California. The facility produces cogeneration steam to aid in an enhanced oil recovery process.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED MODIFICATION

The Energy Commission's certificate included approval of the construction of a steam distribution system, which was considered appurtenant to the power plant itself and thus a part of the project. MSCC is requesting to allow the divestiture of the approximately 9,000 feet of the existing steam distribution system that is no longer needed to operate the Midway Sunset Cogeneration project.

ENERGY COMMISSION AMENDMENT REVIEW PROCEDURES

The purpose of the Energy Commission's review process is to assess the impacts of this proposal on environmental quality and on public health and safety. The review process includes an evaluation of the consistency of the proposed changes with the Energy Commission's Decision and a determination on whether the facility, as modified, would remain in compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (20 Cal. Code of Regs., § 1769). Energy Commission staff is currently analyzing the request and will publish an analysis in the near future. A public hearing for the purpose of approving, denying, or modifying the amendment petition will be held at a regularly scheduled Energy Commission business meeting.
