Pursuant to the Revised Committee Scheduling Order for the Hydrogen Energy California Project (Project), issued on January 27, 2014, we hereby file this Status Report No. 11 on behalf of Hydrogen Energy California LLC (HECA or Applicant). This Status Report provides an overview of key activities by HECA since March 10, 2014, when HECA submitted Status Report No. 10.

I. AGENCY COORDINATION

On February 21, 2014, Applicant received the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Concurrence Letter.

On March 18, 2014, Applicant attended Wasco City Council hearing for an appeal of the approval of Conditional Use Permit 489-87 Amendment, regarding the Wasco coal terminal facility, where the appeal was denied.

II. PUBLIC OUTREACH

A number of public outreach activities have been completed by Applicant since it last reported on public outreach activities, including the following:

 Applicant continues its sponsorship of the Bakersfield Chamber of Commerce "Strictly Business" webcast program, which includes a monthly educational segment on the HECA project and related topics.

- On March 17, 2014, a HECA representative provided an overview of the California Energy Commission permitting process as it relates to the development of major power plants in the state.
- On March 18, 2014, Applicant attended Wasco City Council hearings for an appeal of the approval of Conditional Use Permit 489-87 Amendment regarding the Wasco coal terminal facility that will serve HECA's feedstock needs. Members of the public speaking in support of the matter included local resident Irene Padia who submitted a list of 589 Wasco residents who have signed support cards for HECA.
- On March 20, 2014, Applicant presented a HECA educational overview at the Central Valley Chemical Safety Day forum.
- Applicant continues to participate on the Buttonwillow Community Project as a committee member. This committee is dedicated to the clean-up and revitalization of Buttonwillow and includes local business community/farmers, chamber members, law enforcement and residents.
