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NOTICE OF RECEIPT
PETITION TO CHANGE OPERATOR of the
GWF TRACY COMBINED-CYCLE POWER PLANT (08-AFC-7C)

On March 21, 2014, GWF Energy LLC (GWF) filed a petition with the California Energy Commission (Energy Commission) requesting approval to transfer the operational control of the GWF Tracy Combined-Cycle Power Plant (GWF Tracy) project, from GWF Energy, LLC to Star West Generation Management Company. The original Tracy Peaker Plant, a nominal 169-megawatt simple-cycle facility was certified on July 17, 2002; and began commercial operation on June 1, 2003. In 2008, GWF Energy, LLC, submitted an Application for Certification to the Energy Commission to convert the facility into a combined-cycle power plant with a new nominal generating capacity of 314 megawatts. The Energy Commission issued a decision for the GWF Tracy Combined Cycle Power Plant project on March 24, 2010, and it began commercial operation on November 1, 2012. The facility is located on a 16.38-acre, fenced site within the existing GWF-owned 40-acre parcel in an unincorporated portion of San Joaquin County immediately southwest of Tracy, California, and approximately 20 miles southwest of Stockton, California.

ENERGY COMMISSION REVIEW PROCEDURES

A statement describing the change in operator, signed under penalty of perjury by a representative of the proposed new operator of the project, was submitted to the Energy Commission staff for review and approval as required by Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769(b). The statement affirms that the new operator agrees to be bound by the requirements of the Energy Commission's Decision for the project and understands the obligations imposed by the Conditions of Certification. Based on the information provided, staff intends to recommend the proposed change be approved by the Energy Commission at the June 18, 2014 Business Meeting.

The petition has been docketed on the Energy Commission's GWF Tracy project webpage at <http://www.energy.ca.gov/sitingcases/tracypeaker/>. The Commission's Order, if approved, will also be docketed.

This Notice of Receipt is being provided to interested parties and property owners adjacent to the GWF Tracy site. This Notice has been mailed to the GWF Tracy mail list and sent electronically to the GWF Tracy list serve.

Any person may comment on the petition. Those who wish to comment on the petition can use the Energy Commission's e-commenting feature as follows: Go to the Energy Commission's GWF Tracy Combined-Cycle Power Plant webpage and click on the "Submit e-Comment" link. In the form, provide the required information—your full name, e-mail address, the comment Title, and either a comment or an attached document. The

comment Title should be “[Your Name]’s Comments re Facility Name Petition.” Type your comments into the “Comment Text” field, or upload and attach a document with your comments. The maximum upload file size is 10MB, and only .doc, .docx, or .pdf attachments will be accepted. Enter the CAPTCHA that is used to prevent spamming. Then click on the “Agree and Submit your Comments” button to submit your comments to the Energy Commission Dockets Unit for review. When your comments are approved and docketed, you will receive an e-mail with a link to them on the facility webpage.
