
**Project Description:** 250-megawatt solar thermal generating project using solar parabolic trough technology on 1,765 acres of private land.

**Modification Description:** Update the Abengoa Mojave Solar Power Blocks' general arrangements to replace boiler Volatile Organic Compound control systems, update Heat Transfer Fluid storage tank condensers to include vent scrubbers, reduce the number of Heat Transfer Fluid expansion vessels, replace two Tier II emergency generators with smaller units, reduce stack height on emergency generators to a minimum of 30 feet and fire pump engines to a minimum of 20 feet above ground level, remove operational testing restriction on emergency engines to allow simultaneous emergency equipment testing, and replace two Tier III fire pump engines with two larger Tier III engines. The revised petition also requests removing, adding, and changing various Air Quality Conditions of Certification.

On April 22, 2014, the California Energy Commission approved the above-described project change pursuant to a regulatory program certified by the California Secretary of Resources under Section 21080.5 of the California Public Resources Code.

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the project.
3. The project is compliant with all laws, ordinances, regulations, and standards (LORS); and
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the project.
