Dear Commissioners:


In light of the recent request by Quail Brush Genco, LLC to suspend the Quail Brush Generating Project a second time, I would like to urge the California Energy Commission (CEC) to deny the requested suspension.

As a former Mayor, Current Council Member and longtime public servant for the City of Santee, I ask that you consider the lengthy and costly burden this unnecessary and inappropriate course of action would have on the people of Santee and the entire area. Throughout this process, I have been vocal in advocating against this project. No length of time, further review or second suspension will make this project a viable solution. Impacts on air quality, biological, visual, noise and fire hazards are among the many detrimental impacts this project would have on our region.

The California Public Utilities Commission denied the project because it is not needed and is incompatible with the plans for our area.
