Dear Committee Members:

On April 10, 2014, the California Energy Commission's ("**CEC**") El Segundo Energy Center Amendment Committee docketed its Committee Order for Status Reports, Including Schedule Recommendations (the "**Committee Order**") for the Petition to Amend (the "**PTA**") the El Segundo Energy Center (00-AFC-14C) (the "**Project**"). In accordance with the Committee Order, this letter constitutes El Segundo Energy Center LLC's ("**ESEC LLC**") Status Report 5 for the Project.

During the 4 weeks since ESEC LLC filed its Status Report 4 (CEC TN #202240), ESEC LLC has provided CEC staff with ESEC LLC's proposed figure for Condition of Certification NOISE 8 (TN No. 202376), and 2 sets of supplemental Cultural Resources records search results (see TN Nos. 202318-1, 202318-2, and 202373). This Cultural Resources data represents all of the supplemental information requested by CEC staff that is currently available in the California Historical Resources Information System databases for Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

On May 5, 2014, ESEC LLC filed its written responses (the "**Responses**") to CEC staff's Preliminary Staff Assessment of the Project (the "**PSA**"). Staff docketed its Status Report 6 on May 16, 2014. On Monday, May 19, 2014, CEC staff docketed its request for expanded explanations of the Responses regarding Conditions of Certification BIO-9, -10, -16 and -17. ESEC LLC will file its answer to this request as quickly as possible.

ESEC LLC expects that the South Coast Air Quality Management District ("**SCAQMD**") will issue its Final Determination of Compliance in mid-June based on a recent update from the SCAQMD. This publication should allow CEC staff to issue its Final Staff Assessment in mid-July.
