**NRG SAN GABRIEL POWER GENERATION LLC  
SUSPENSION STATUS REPORT NUMBER 25**

In accordance with the Order Suspending Proceeding dated May 30, 2013 (“Order”), the applicant in this proceeding, NRG San Gabriel Power Generation LLC (“San Gabriel”), submits its suspension status report number 25. The Order instructed San Gabriel to file and serve monthly status reports.

The San Gabriel Generating Station is a proposed 696 megawatt natural gas-fired electricity generating facility to be located at the site of an existing power plant in Rancho Cucamonga, California, within the jurisdiction of the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“SCAQMD”). San Gabriel requested suspension of this proceeding due to permitting difficulties associated with the unavailability within the South Coast Air Basin of certain emission offsets needed to satisfy applicable SCAQMD rules.

To allow more time to address the ongoing development and permitting challenges, San Gabriel has submitted a request for further suspension of the proceeding. The reasons for the request are explained in San Gabriel’s May 23, 2014 filing in this proceeding.
