

Dear Committee Members:

On May 29, 2014, the California Energy Commission’s (“**CEC**”) El Segundo Energy Center Amendment Committee docketed its Revised Committee Scheduling Order (the “**Scheduling Order**”) for the Petition to Amend (the “**PTA**”) the El Segundo Energy Center (00-AFC-14C) (the “**Project**”). Accordingly, El Segundo Energy Center LLC (“**ESEC LLC**”) submits this Status Report 6.

On May 19, 2014, CEC staff requested expanded explanations of ESEC LLC’s comments on the Biological Resources Conditions of Certification that staff proposed in the Preliminary Staff Assessment of the Project. ESEC LLC promptly docketed supplemental information regarding its responses on May 30, 2014, as CEC TN# 202401.

Furthermore, as mentioned in ESEC LLC’s Status Report 5 (CEC TN# 202377), ESEC LLC expects that the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“**SCAQMD**”) will issue its Final Determination of Compliance in mid-June. This publication should allow CEC staff to issue its Final Staff Assessment in mid-July.
