As part of the Alternatives development and screening process for the RBEP Preliminary Staff Assessment, the San Gabriel Coastal Spreading Grounds located at 8467 E. Loch Lomond Dr. in Pico Rivera, CA was identified as a potential alternative site for the proposed RBEP.

The site is currently being used as a water conservation facility adjacent to the Rio Hondo river channel to permit water to percolate into groundwater basins for later pumping. This site is owned and operated by the Los Angeles County Public Works Department, Water Resources Division.

After staff's site visit on June 12, staff contacted LA County to ascertain the status of the site ownership, and whether the site was available for sale or lease. Staff described the proposed project briefly to Ken Zimmer. He indicated that the site is currently owned by LA County Public Works, and is not available for lease or sale for any other use.
