ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION OF PROCEEDINGS

On June 10, 2014, the Applicant, Valle Del Sol Energy, LLC, filed a written request that the suspension of proceedings in this matter, currently set to expire on June 30, 2014, be extended for a year.

The suspension shall expire June 30, 2015. In its June 1, 2015 status report, Applicant shall indicate whether or not it will seek a further suspension. If further suspension is desired, Applicant shall file such a request on or before the above expiration date.
