I have emailed Governor Brown as well.

Mayor and City Council Members,
I have just received a letter from SCAQMD stating they are issuing permits for the revised AES plant. Two items struck me, #1 "All of the NOx and SOx emissions from this facility have to be offset with emission credits that AES Huntington Beach, LLC either holds or purchases through the Regional Clean Air Incentive's Market (RECLAIM) in the form of RECLAIM Trading Credits(RTCs). PLEASE note the NOx is Nitrogen Oxides, and SOx are Sulfur Oxides!! Even more serious is the 24,000 GALLON aqueous AMMONIA storage tank they want to build!!! I cannot believe they are going to put this next to a neighborhood that has a high school, and an elementary school in very close proximity to it, not to

mention several hundred homes. Huntington Beach prides itself on it's beautiful beaches so let's try to clean up the area, not pollute more. The ammonia storage tank is outrageous, as accidents happen. Southeast HB is NOT a third world country. I will address this directly with SCAQMD as well.
