### **Background**

On July 21, 2014, the Committee conducted an Evidentiary Hearing in Huntington Beach, California. This notice sets a second day of hearings to receive evidence limited to the following subject matters:

  - Conditions of Certification

All parties are **ORDERED** to file a Prehearing Statement to include the following information:

- 1. A description of the specific issues under each topic described above that the party believes are still in dispute;
- 2. The identity of each witness the party intends to sponsor on the identified subject matter and whether such witness will appear in person, by declaration, or telephonically. No party may identify a witness whose testimony has not been previously docketed, unless otherwise ordered by the Committee;
- 3. The amount of time each party requires to
  - a. present testimony of each witness identified above and
  - **b.** question the witness(es) of any other party.

The Prehearing Statement described above shall be filed no later than 3:00 p.m. on July 31, 2014, unless otherwise directed by the Committee. The Committee may hold each party to its estimated time for testimony and questioning. *Note*: A party who fails to provide the scope, relevance and time for questioning other parties' witness(es) risks preclusion from questioning on that subject area.

In addition to the Prehearing Statement, for those questions presented in the Order after Prehearing Conference (that document can be found here: http://docketpublic.energy.ca.gov/PublicDocuments/12-AFC-

# Notice of Committee's Intention to Use Informal Hearing Procedures

Pursuant to Government Code, section 11445.10 et seq., and section 1217 of the Commission's regulations, the Committee intends to conduct the Continued Evidentiary Hearing using an informal procedure. **The Committee would like to emphasize the informal hearing process' need for succinct statements and short questions and answers.** 

#### **Notice of Closed Session Deliberations**

At any time during the hearing, the Committee may adjourn to a closed session in accordance with California Government Code section 11126, subdivision (c)(3), which allows a state body, including a delegated committee, to hold a closed session to deliberate on a decision to be reached in a proceeding the state body was required by law to conduct.

### **Notice of Tentative Staff Workshop**

Staff may discuss proposed changes to its analysis and recommendations, including proposed conditions of certification, with any other party only in a public meeting and only after providing notice. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, §1710, subd. (a).) In order to effectuate resolution of issues still outstanding after the Evidentiary Hearing on July 21, 2014, the Committee may, as needed, allow staff the opportunity to conduct a Staff Workshop during a recess from the Continued Evidentiary Hearing on August 6, 2014.

### **Transcripts**

Parties are responsible for identifying errors in the transcripts of the proceedings. Corrections to the transcripts must be submitted to the Committee within 30 days of the filing of a transcript.

### **Public Adviser and Public Participation**

Members of the public are welcome to attend and offer oral or written comments at the prehearing conference and at the evidentiary hearing. It is not necessary to be an Intervenor to participate in the public process. Interested members of the public are encouraged to submit written comments using the e-commenting system described above.
