## BACKGROUND

The Petition for Insignificant Project Change states that PG&E proposes to: 1) Relocate the area lighting and associated electrical power supply conduit runs currently located along the perimeter of the cited open Steam Turbine Deck areas; 2) Install grating in the areas marked in red as depicted in the figure (PG&E 2014:1). However, the depth of these ground-disturbing activities is not known, and thus staff is unable to assess the potential for the project changes to impact unknown, buried cultural resource deposits.

## **DATA REQUESTS**

- Please provide, with as much detail as the proposed amendment's design will
  permit, a description of the horizontal extent and depth of excavation for
  removing and relocating the conduit, and installing the deck and grating.
- Please provide documentation (e.g., a geotechnical report) of the depth of artificial fill, if present, in the areas where ground-disturbing activities are proposed.
